

Manteau 28/02/1918 Coat

This coat needs 5 patterns

Trace:

- * the back (dos), sleeves (manches) and collar (col) at the fold of double fabric
- * the front (devant) on double fabric

Cut out: on the very edge of the patterns

The belt is a strip of fabric of 5cm by 26 cm (2" x 10" ¼)

If you prefer you can make a lining for this coat (or just the collar and belt) by using the same patterns. Cut the lining slightly larger than the fabric pieces

Assembling

Stitch the lining on your collar (or turn under the seams (rentre))

Stitch. You can put your collar standing straight up as in the picture or rest on the shoulders

Adjust your hem/lining side of the collar to this choice. Clip where needed

Close the shoulder seams c/b (epaule). With right sides together, pin and stitch the collar to your coat. Press and clip

Adjust the sleeves to the armholes. Pin, Stitch, Press and clip where needed

Close side seams of sleeves and body

Add press buttons or tiny hooks

Belt: add lining or stitch the seams.

The belt closes with a press button or hook
