

## **Vetement de voyage ou de pluie 18/09/1919 Travell or raincoat**

This is a coat without sleeves, we need three patterns to make it.

Back and front have the same pattern, there is a stole/ large collar (three pieces, one pattern) and a hood

**Trace** the back, the hood and the back piece of the stole at the fold of double fabric

**Trace** the front and the frontpiece of the stole on double fabric

**Cut out** the patternpieces

### **Stitch:**

**Sleeveless coat:** close shoulder and sideseams, turn under the seams at the armholes.

Stitch the bottomhem

**Hood:** Close the backseam, hem the hood (leave the neckline open)

**Stole:** stitch the sideseams, hem the stole (leave the neckline open)

### **Assembling:**

Now carefull assemble hood, stole and coat, make sure centerbacks are corresponding.

Put backside of the hood at the backside of the coat

Put the stole on top of it: right side of the hood gets now on right side of the hood

Pin and stitch the three layers

The coat closes with a pressbutton or add button and loop

This coat is made in one colour or checkered, plaid fabric. Use cotton, wool or impermeable fabric. Of course you can use any fabric choosen or given by your maman!

Perline: stole

Capuchon: hood

Moitié dos: half of the back

Pli de l' étoffe: fold of the fabric

Couture: stitch (seam)

l' encolure: neckopening
