

Bleurette travers le monde NO 6 06/02/1930 ARABE

No matter if your little bleurette is blond or has dark hair, she will look great in this Arabian outfit! (Her hair will be hidden in the veil anyway)

Pants

Fold the fabric double and double again in opposite direction

Put the pattern of the very large pants (white pattern on the sketch) on both folds so you can cut out the pants in one piece only (centerfront is on the fold, the bottom also is without seams) Close the sideseams of your pants. Hem the leg openings.

Narrow hem the waist

Gather the waist of the pants by two rows of gathers

A belt (6 cm width = 2 ¼ inch) knotted on the front holds the pants to the waist.

Bleurette wears also a little linon or silky undershirt (no pattern given)

Bolero

Made in cherry coloured velvet, decorated with little 'paillets' (straws? = flat beads)

There are two pattern pieces. The back is placed at the fold of double fabric. The front on double fabric. After assembling, stitch a silver or golden soutache braid on the outer edges.

Make tiny bows

The veil, decorated with 'paillets', comes just under her eyes. A larger veil dresses her head
A funny hat, cut out of paper. Cover the hat with the same silk of the veil. Roll together and glue
