

LA JAQUETTE DE L'ENSEMBLE DE BLEUETTE

This lovely jacket goes with the Ensemble for our Bleuette to finish off the look of this fashion. There is no closure to this jacket so the printed vest underneath will show.

Cut the jacket back pattern piece out on the fold of your fabric. This jacket should also be lined so you will want to cut out the lining along with the jacket fabric. The front is two separate pieces. The sleeves are quite roomy and wide at the wrists.

Sew shoulder seams of the jacket fab. and also of the lining fab..

Sew a gathering thread through the upper edge of the sleeves...both fabric and lining. Pull the thread and sewing each sleeve fitted into the armholes..

Press. Place right sides of fab. and lining together sew up the front edges and around the neckline of the jacket. Turn RSD and Press. Turn fab sleeve (WST (wrong sides together) and seam the under sleeve and side seams up ...also the same with the lining. Adjust the sleeves so that the lining goes inside the jacket fab. sleeve. Turn the cuff hem in and hand sew these with a over-cast stitch or stitch of your choice. Turn up the bottom hem edges of the jacket and stitch this closed.. As in the diagram picture, you may want to apply decorative trim to the jacket and sleeves.
