

LA CHEMISETTE DE L'ENSEMBLE DE BLEUETTE

This is the short-sleeve blouse that goes with the Ensemble for Bleurette.

Made of crepe of China, voile or silky white canvas...or fabric of your choice.

The front is cut on the fold of the fabric. The opening will be in the back and closes with a row of buttons (which can be just decorative over snaps.

Reproduction. instructions;

I lined the front and back of this blouse. First sew shoulder seams of the fabric and also of the lining pieces. Press open. WRT (with right sides together) Stitch up each back closure edge., turn blouse right side out and press. Stitch a gathering stitch around the neck opening lining and fabric together..

Sleeves; Stitch a gathering thread around the upper part of each sleeve and also one through the bottom edge of each sleeve.. pull the top thread to make the sleeve fit into the armhole of the blouse and sew in place. Pull the thread at the bottom of the sleeve to gather and fit to the sleeve cuff and WRT stitch cuff in place. Turn blouse wrong side out and sew up side seams and underarms. turn cuff back and turn under...hand stitch this in place.

Turn right side out and press. Pulling the gathering thread around the neckline fit the neck binding to fit and WRT stitch in place. Turn the binding back and under and hand stitch in place.

Hem bottom of the blouse. Sew snaps up the back and also buttons for looks
