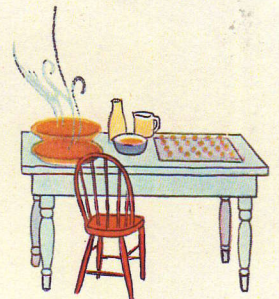


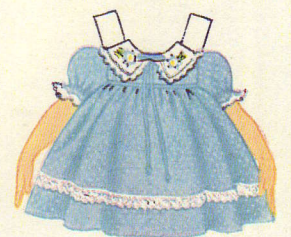
BETSY McCALL'S party month
