

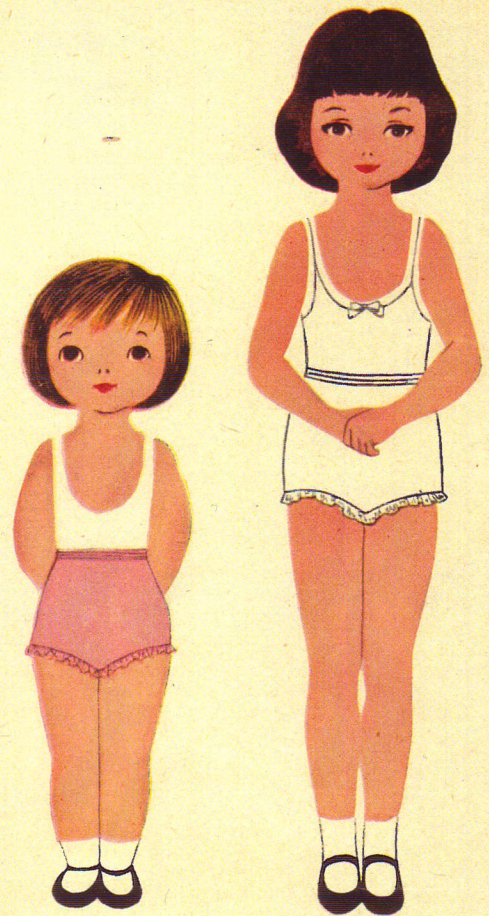
Betsy McCall goes to an Easter-egg hunt

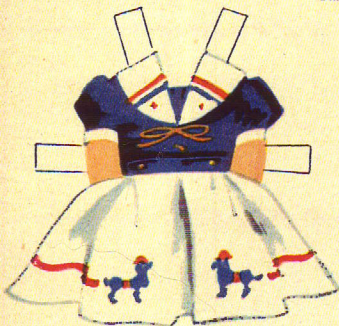

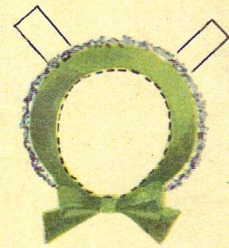

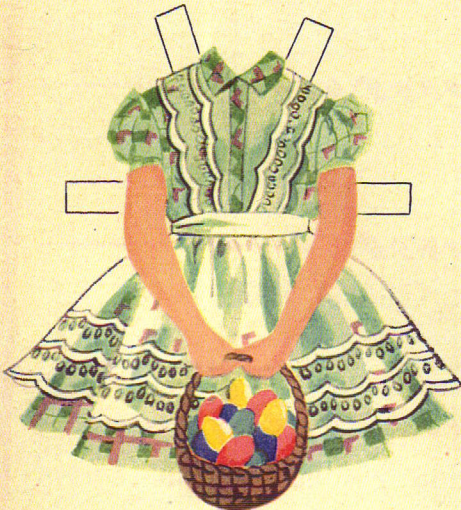
Linda's sailor dress with the navy bodice and the poodles



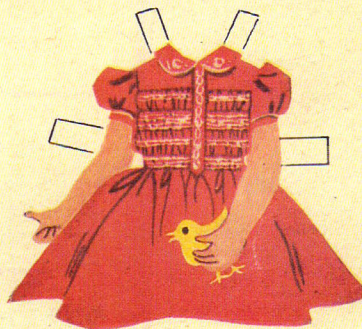
Betsy's sun dress with red fish on the skirt and a navy jacket



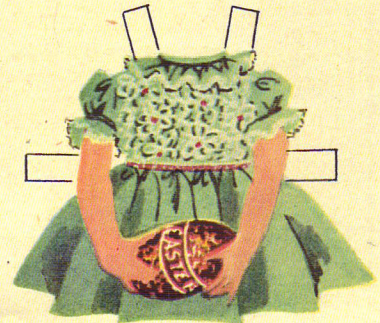
The bonnet with big bow that matches Linda's green dress
