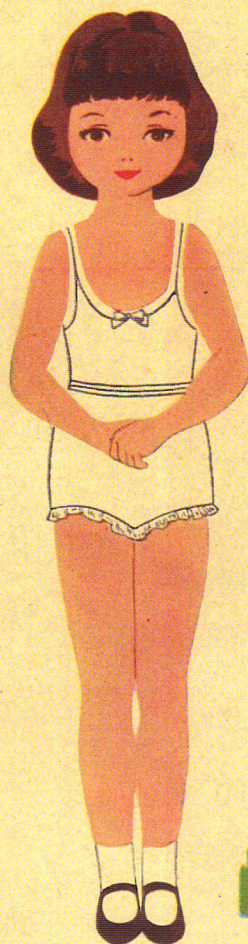

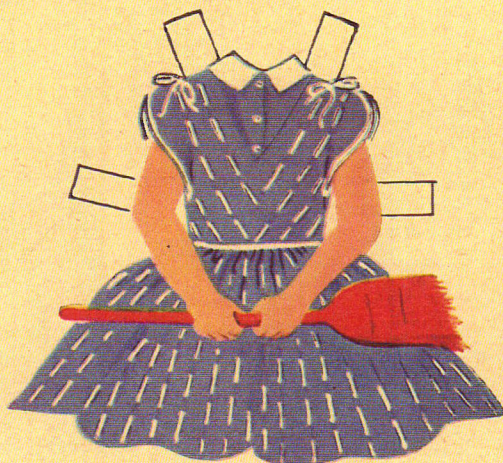

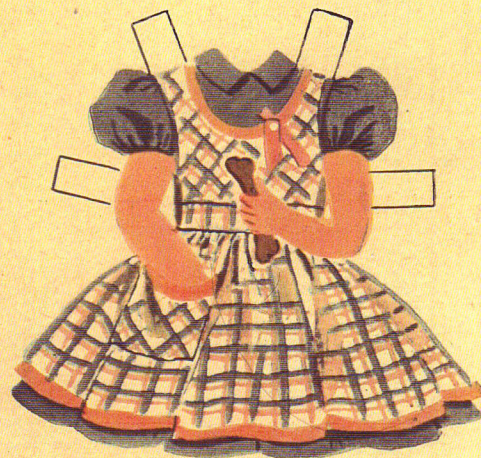
BETSY McCALL'S SURPRISE DRESSES



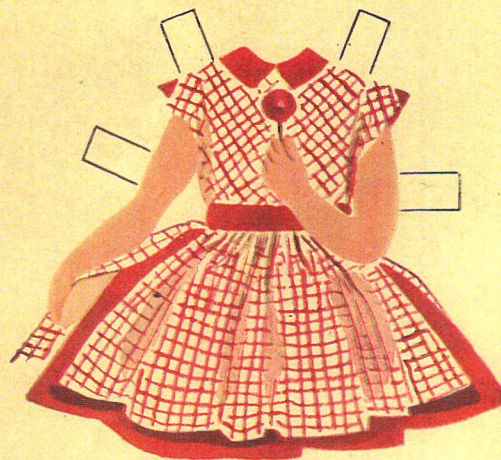
Betsy can wear her jumper without the blouse and—surprise. It's a sundress!
