

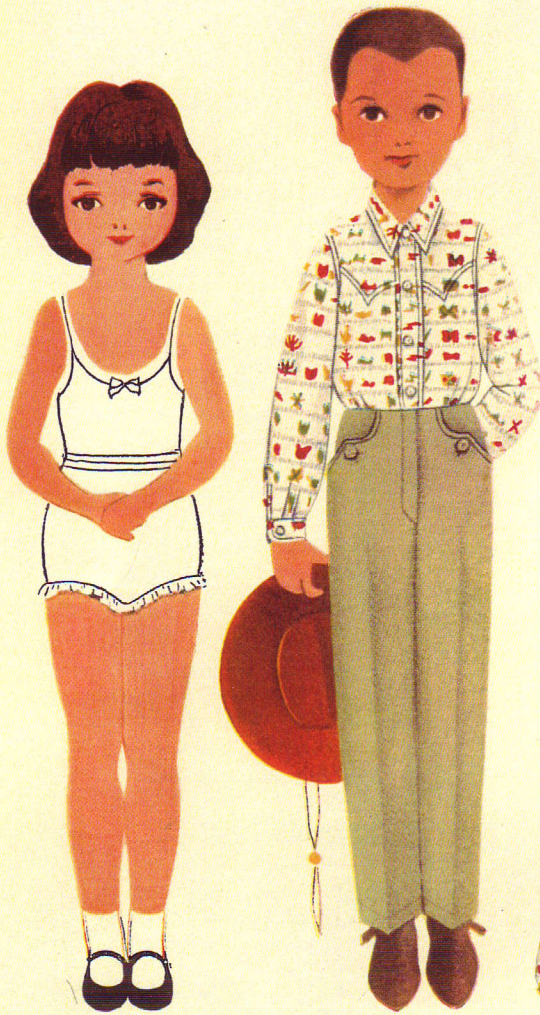
# Betsy McCall goes Western

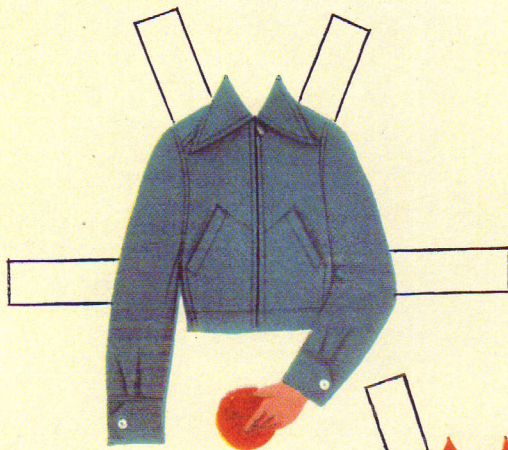

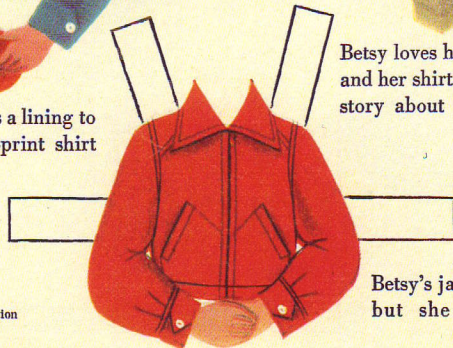
This is Jimmy Weeks
