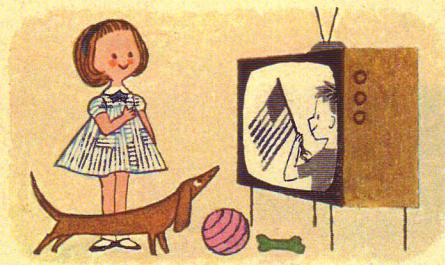


Betsy McCall's Cousin Linda goes to "Romper Room"



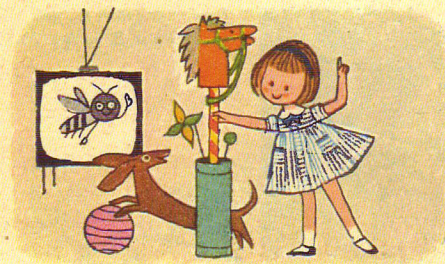

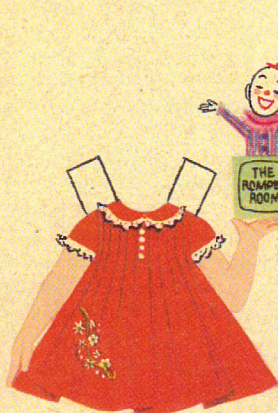
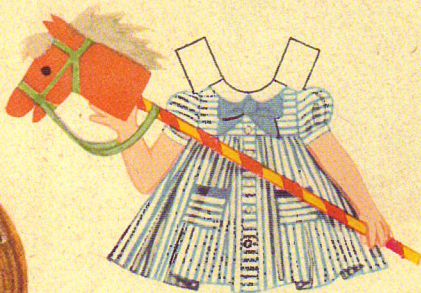


"I know all about the new state named Alaska we're going to have, 'cause we're pretending to go there on our brones. It has volcanoes and a great big iceberg"

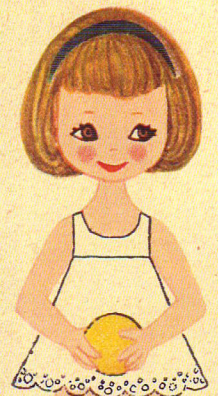
