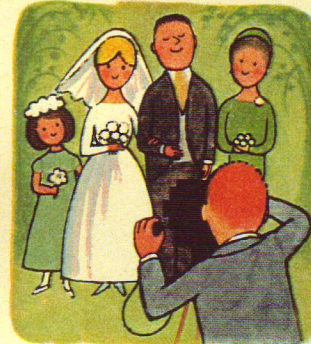

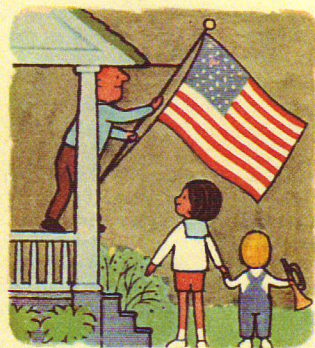

## Betsy McCall Calendar for 1965

This new calendar is so easy to make! All you need are twelve unruled white file cards, 3 by 5 inches; a small printed calendar for 1965; a small jar of rubber cement or library paste; and some wool yarn or very narrow silk ribbon. You'll find all these things at the five-and-dime. Now, cut out the pictures, neat as neat, and paste one carefully on each card, one

inch below the top of the card and with equal borders on each side. In the space below it, paste the proper calendar page, carefully centered. When the pasting is done, punch two holes in the top of each card. String them all together with the wool or ribbon, and leave a loop with which to hang up your calendar. What a wonderful New Year present it will make!
