



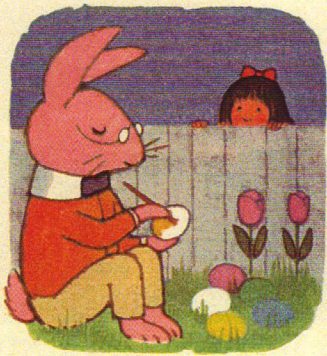

Betsy McCall Calendar for 1966

Here's a lovely calendar to keep or give as a present. And here's how to make it. Buy a dozen unruled white cards, 3 by 5 inches, a jar or tube of paste, a small calendar and half a yard of red baby ribbon. You can find everything at the five-and-ten. Now, carefully as you can, cut out the 12 rectangles above.



Just as you see in the drawing at the left, center a picture on the card, and paste it on neatly. Below it, paste the calendar page for the appropriate month. When your pictures are mounted and dry, make two holes at the top, and run the ribbon through, to fasten the cards together. Tie ends in a bow.
