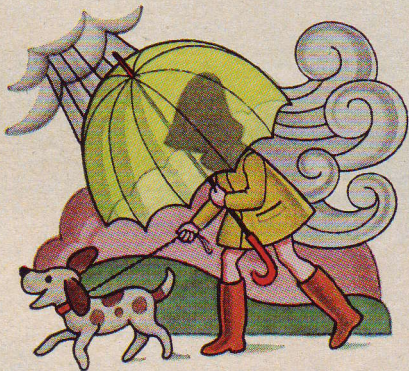

It's easy to make this beautiful Betsy McCall Calendar, and the little drawing at right shows you how. You'll need 12 white, unlined, 3-by-5-inch cards; a tube of library paste; a tiny printed 1975 calendar; half a yard of narrow red or green ribbon. Now cut out each of the above pictures



very carefully. Turn the card lengthwise, and paste a picture on it; below the picture, paste the calendar page for the month. When all are mounted and dry, make two holes at the top of each card. Run ribbon through the holes to hold cards together. Tie ribbon ends in a bow.
