

This is the neatest tent.....and she made the frame from tinkertoys!
Mary.....any chance of getting dimensions and instructions?? The sides are 16" long - 14" tall.... so I cut a piece of fabric 14 1/4" X 72" long....using the selvage edge as the bottom of the tent.... I turned under the seams on the ends of the piece (these are the edges of the front door flaps). I cut 4 triangles 16 1/2" at the bottom with 9" from that to the top/tip of the triangle... sewed these together with 1/4" seams for the roof.... I folded the long wall piece in half and centered this point on one side of the roof.... pinned it in place - with overlapping the front flaps and sewed it up. The red cross on the roof was an "after thought"... I probably would recommend sewing it on before you attach the roof to walls... then I just used the wood "wheel" pieces of the tinker toys on 1/4" dowels into the four corners of the tent....with dowels between each to support the tent....glued wood spools to the bottoms to make those a little more stable....and voila!....a first aid tent....

Does that make sense?? MaryColgan
